LICENSED REPRESENTATIVE ELECTIONS

CCEA SOT Elections
September 7, 2017

What is your role?

- ✓ Encourage staff to vote for themselves or others. (Staff do not have to have been nominated.)
- ✓ Share the CCEA election flyers.
- ✓ Announce the election on September 7.

SUPPORT STAFF ELECTIONS

ESEA Elections
September 11-14, 2017

What is your role?

- ✓ Encourage staff to vote for themselves or others.
- ✓ Share the ESEA election flyers with all staff regardless of union membership. **ESEA will honor election results if association membership requirements cannot be met!**
- ✓ Announce the election throughout the week on September 11-14.
- ✓ Make sure support staff have access to a computer to vote.

PARENT/GUARDIAN ELECTIONS

PTA, PTO or Principal

What is your role?

- ✓ Work with your PTA/PTO. No PTA/PTO? Run an election (however and whenever you choose)!
- ✓ Make sure all parents (regardless of PTA/PTO membership) have the opportunity to run for election and vote!
- ✓ Make sure the vote counting is transparent and unbiased.

STUDENT ELECTIONS

- ✓ Run an election (however and whenever you choose)!
- ✓ Make sure all students have the opportunity to run for election and vote!
